

Late December 2016: MPP will form a drafting advisory committee composed of stakeholders in Michigan and experts in marijuana policy who will volunteer their time to help draft the initiative. This committee will meet regularly and will have an opportunity to review several drafts of the initiative before it is finalized.

January 2, 2017: MPP will be accepting written comments and suggestions until January 2. Please send any comments to Lissa Satori at <u>info@regulatemichigan.org</u>.

Late February 2017: MPP will circulate a draft of the initiative for public review and comment. The draft will be posted on our website. We will provide notice as the date approaches and will allow at least one week for review and comment. Late April 2017: The final petitions will be filed and the signature drive will begin.

- 252,523 signatures will be required for an initiative, or 315,654 signatures will be required for a constitutional amendment.
- Signed petitions will be submitted for verification in October.
